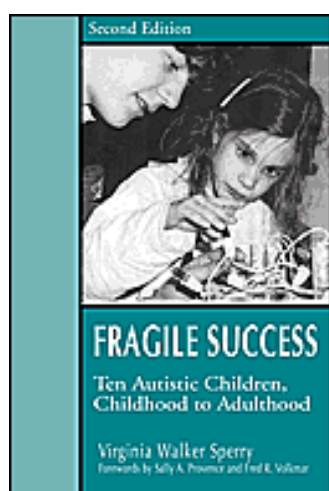


## Experiences of the Whole Family

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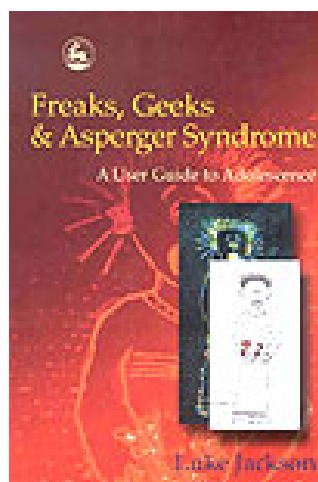
Taking a broad view of the impact on family life of having a child with autism, this booklet examines the impact on grandparents and the wider family circle.
