---

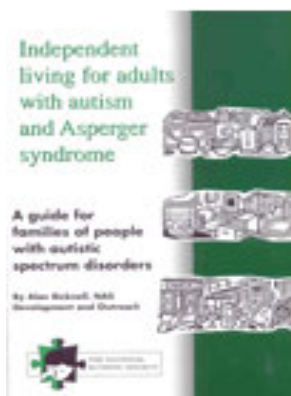
